The Background: In the late 1990's some major changes took place in the club. The back room was updated, the far back area added, the front reconfigured, the driveway paved etc. In order to help defray the cost of these projects the Twentieth Century Club was established. Its purpose was to reduce debt and prepare the club to enter the new millennium. The goal was to raise \$30,000 by soliciting donations of \$100 from 100 members and \$1000 from 20 members. The response was a tremendous success, but short of the full goal. The \$21,000 raised made it possible for the club to continue its long range planning.

In recent years, the exterior improvements have continued, bar and food services have been established, a front patio added, and the docks built. Other projects, such as the pavilion and storage barn, are on the drawing board and will enhance the club's appearance, reputation and service to members. Finishing the Twentieth Century Club will once again reduce debt and position the club for the new projects.
