Our membership consists of power boaters, sail boaters, non-boaters, and a few ferry boaters. The Club season spans from early May to early October, although we also sponsor winter events to allow us a regular boating “fix.”

The Club is active in several boating organizations including AYC (Associated Yacht Clubs) and I-LYA (Interlake Yachting Association). The Club serves as host for the I-LYA Junior Sailing championships in July, Senior Sail and Power Regattas in August, and sponsors a hospitality suite at the association spring meeting. The Club is also frequently asked to host special boating events. Because of these affiliations, a PIBYC membership card grants access to facilities around the country and beyond (our Fleet Surgeon received a hearty welcome from the Hobart Yacht Club while traveling in Australia).

Just as membership in PIBYC carries these privileges, it also carries responsibility. We are first and foremost a volunteer organization, and all members are asked to contribute whatever skills they can – we have a job for everyone.
