We are already well underway to make 2010 the year of maintaining and updating our facilities, both inside and outside. Landscaping was designed by Vivien Dennerll and crew; plants and mulch were donated by Tom Thompson of Thompson Landscaping.

They have made arrangements for new front doors and replacement of fogged windows in the Bayview room.

The Bayview room was painted in late fall by Dave Butz and Roger Ingle with the help of Kris Miller, Bob Frimel and Ed Skoch who moved the furniture and dismantled the bar which was cleaned.

Repairs were made to areas on the roof that had leaks; hopefully we found them all.

The docks are freshly painted and is ready for the season thanks to PC Bob Bahnney, Trustee Roger Ingle, PC John Spencer, Walter Duff, PC Tom Cooper, PC Clark Davies and Club Manager Kris Miller. The side entranceway was repainted by Jason Cooper and a new sign will be placed at this entranceway.

Steve Nagy is working on plumbing repairs. We had two proposals for much needed repairs to our parking area and drains; the proposals will be presented to the Board at our next meeting for their review and approval.

Our volunteer club enthusiasts have certainly made a difference, putting true meaning to the phrase, "If everyone does a little bit, then no one person has to do it all." Please help make our club the place you want to enjoy while making new friends.

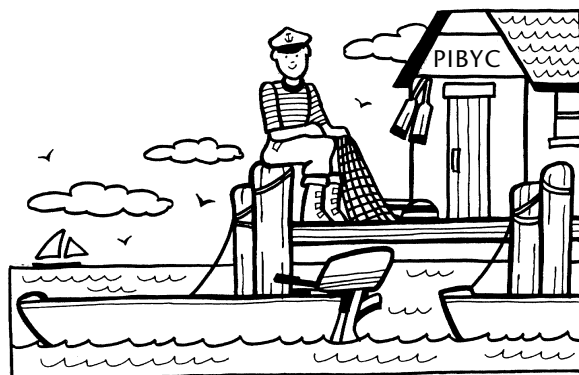

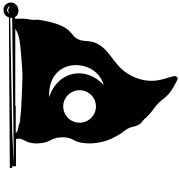
