Adult Sailing Report

The Sailing Series for 2011 was a great success, getting in 79 races over the summer in 4 separate series:

On Saturday June 23 at 9:00 a.m. the fleet will put on a Sailing Clinic on Hobie Waves with chalk talks, video and on-the-water training. The group will use the format of Rick White's Sailing Seminars, which originated in 1989, has graduated over 3000 sailors (most of whom are usually in the winner's circle), and has coached at least 8 Olympic Medalists.

The course is broken down into segments, followed by drills on the water to practice each segment. By the end of the day, students will put it all together and become accomplished sailors.

Coaches will be on several power boats advising students throughout the day, and they really know what they are talking about. The PIBYC Fleet is loaded with talent, with two World Champs, 5 National Champs, and 4 North American Champs. We want to use that talent to teach others how to sail.

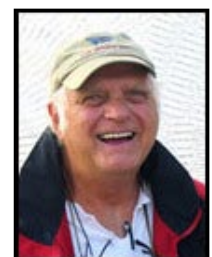
The clinic is open to all ages and all talent levels, from beginners to novices, to advanced racers. All will gain a lot from the course.

Hobie Waves will be provided for the clinic. They are 13' catamarans with one sail, made of plastic and, nearly impossible to damage.

The following Saturday, June 30th at 11:00 a.m., the yacht club will be put on the Men's Day Regatta, a round-robin fun-sailing event. Hopefully, with all the new talented sailors we will have on the island after taking the Sailing Clinic from the previous week, there will be an excellent turnout. Hobie Waves will again be provided. Just bring yourself and a PFD.

The fleet of nine "new to us" race-ready club 420s replaces the boats lost in the barn fire in July. Special thanks to Miller Boat Line for helping with transportation to the island and to Joe Fegen for engineering and coordinating the purchase and delivery of the boats which are already packed away in the newly repaired and freshly painted storage barn at PIBYC. The well-maintained fleet, purchased from Plymouth Yacht Club, will be used for sailing classes and racing next summer and for many years to come. The purchase was made possible through the support of our island community and, in particular, PIBYC which remains an unwavering champion of the

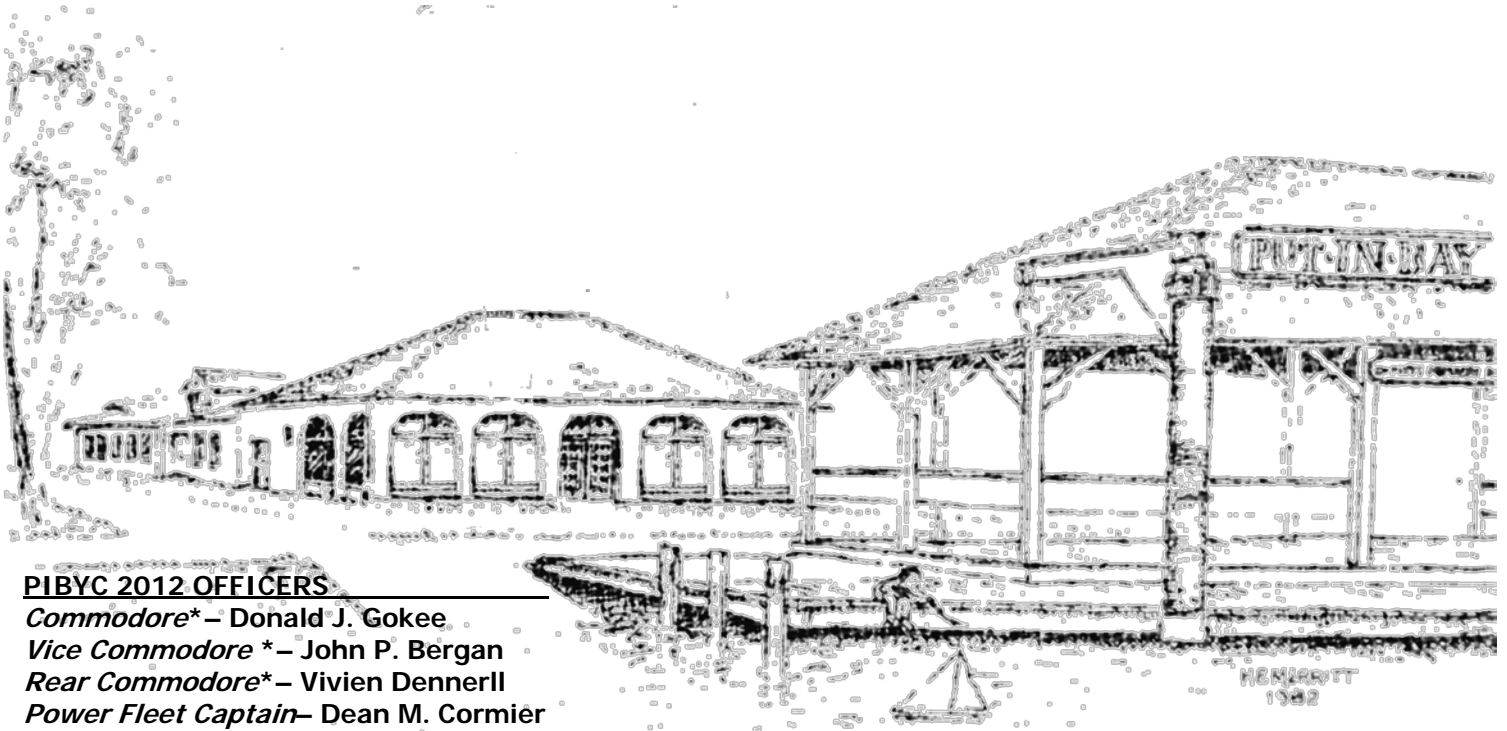
