## In Remembrance



**JAMES H. HANNAN**  
06/11/1938 - 04/02/2010

Roger and Vivien Dennerll first got to know James H. Hannan when they first joined PIBYC in 2005. They did not know anybody, and he joined them for a dinner at the club. He seemed to enjoy talking about his joy of being able to visit the island area of Lake Erie on his 26 foot pleasure boat that he docked at Treasure Cove Marina, which he named "**Twirp**." Roger found the name unusual and asked how the name came about. He stated, "*My nickname.*" Jim told them about his favorite event at PIBYC, which was the Winter Doldrums, and he enjoyed being part of it all. At the 2008 Winter Doldrums when Roger was the Rear Commodore, Jim assisted them in setting up for the events.

We learned that Jim had been a member of PIBYC since 1995, a Veteran of the U. S. Army, retired from General Motors, and a member of the Port Clinton Legion of the Moose Lodge 1610. He was a graduate of Aquinas College High School and active in the Saint Aquinas scholarship fund, and St. Andrew Parish.

But, what he enjoyed the most was the Winter Doldrums, and Saturday night dinners at Treasure Cove, which allowed him to be in the island area he loved.

At the 2010 Winter Doldrums Roger & Vivien invited Jim to sit with them at their dinner table at the Mon Ami. Jim loved people and enjoyed talking with everyone he met. He passed away on April 2, 2010 shortly after the Winter Doldrums, and in his Estate he left a *very generous* donation to the PIBYC of \$83,670.

We will rendezvous as guests of [The Old Club](#) on Harsens Island in the South Channel of the St. Clair River (42-32-3 N 082-40-156W) Sunday July 8<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup>. The Harbor Master monitors VHV 9. You must call in for a dock assignment when you arrive.

If you would like to attend but can't make the whole week you may sign up for as many days as you'd like. Plan to arrive early if you can to take full advantage of the facilities. Throughout the week there will be plenty of leisure time and practice time for tennis, croquet, trap shooting, or golf. The longest hole is 120 yards, so bring your 7-9 iron and a putter. The pool and bar will also be open for your enjoyment.

Bring your dingy and ply the beautiful arteries of the St. Clair River's endless haunts. We'll venture out to explore various watering holes and eateries throughout the week. Don't have a boat? Boat too small but you would still like to dingy around. Trailer it up and stay at the Old Club's "[Ritz Hotel](#)" right there on the island with your cruising comrades. Cost is \$96.00/night (plus tax) Call 810-748-9931 to make your reservation. Be sure to ask for the gate code or give me (Dean Cormier 734-755-7373) a call if you forget.

We'll gather to share stories of the day's exploits, enjoy hors d'oeuvres and dinner on a couple evenings (TBD), as well as Friday for breakfast before departing. No rush to check out though, you're welcome to indulge up to 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Dress is casual so long as men always wear a collared shirt and everyone leaves their blue jeans in their lockers, bathing suits by the pool only, and no hats indoors for the gentlemen. Feel free to serve cocktails on your boat but you need to abstain from consuming private stock on the docks or anywhere on the premises.

Be sure to check in at the office when upon arrival and get your club ID number for the duration of your stay. All purchases go on your account (no cash) and your final bill will be mailed to your home. Cost per head will be approximately \$100.00 for the planned meals only, including tax and gratuity and depending on your menu selection(s). All beverages and any other meals or ships store items you opt for at the club are at your own additional expense. There is a \$20.00/per day/per person grounds fee which provides for complete access to all the Club's facilities. Dockage is \$1.75/foot/night and trap shooting is \$15.00/round including shells and use of a shotgun.

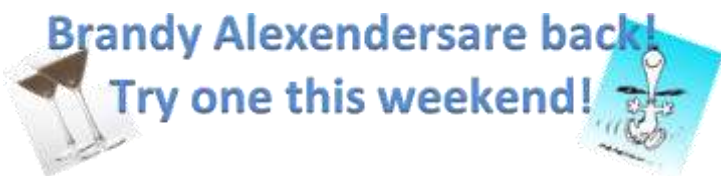

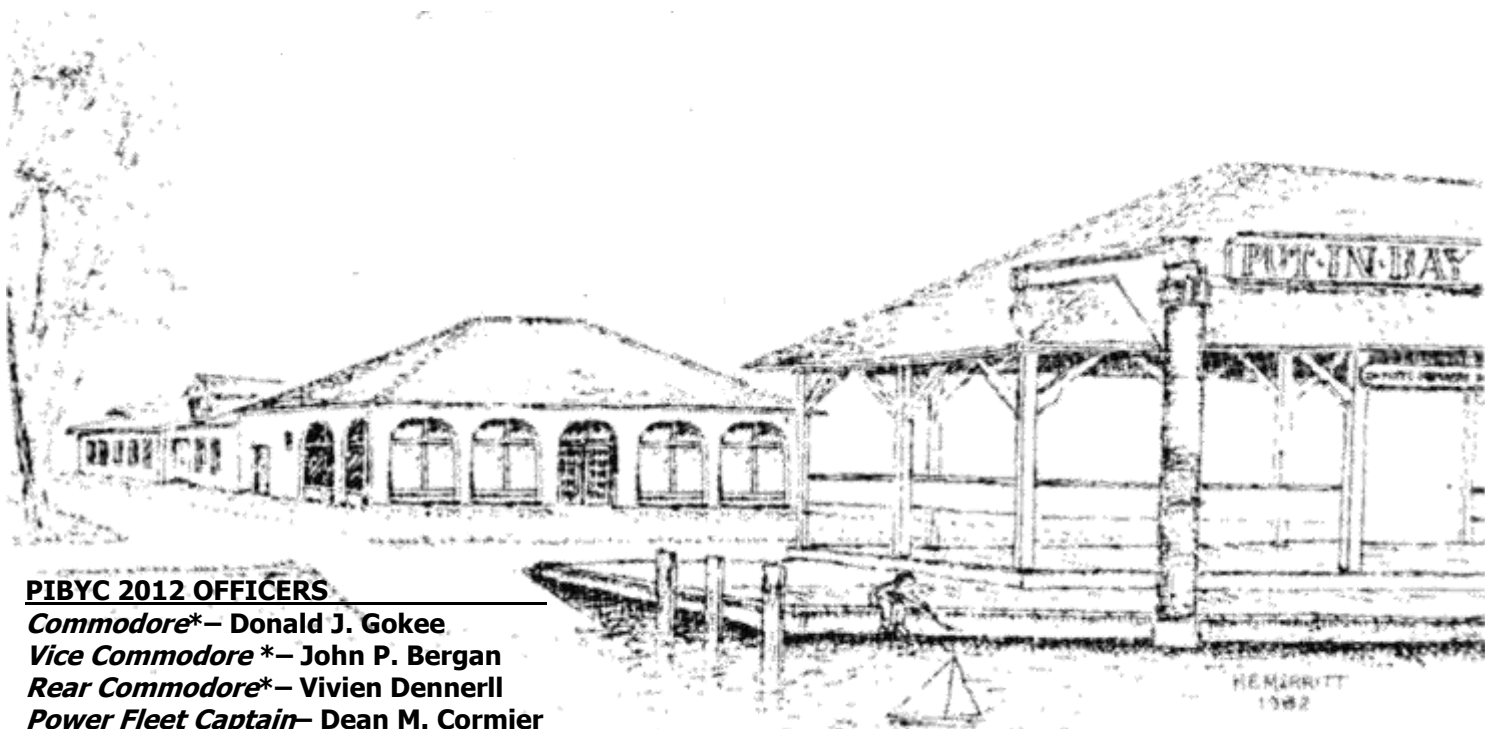
