## IN MEMORIUM John "Bullet" Borman

Our long-time friend, member and Past Commodore, John Borman, passed away suddenly on June 26, 2011. John joined PIBYC in 1962 and served as our Commodore in 1976. He was a Past Commodore of AYC (1973), and trustee of the I-LYA Yachtsman Fund.

At a time the centerboards faced elimination from the I-LYA Regatta, John stepped forward and championed their cause, saving that group. He was the race officer for the centerboard fleet for many years and assisted with many other races that ended at the island.

John was the founder of many island activities including the 4 o'clock club, 5 o'clock club and the Bullet Borman Breakfast Club. John was the recipient of the PIBYC Jim Crain award for Enduring Volunteer Contributions in 1997.

He was as comfortable on the bow of a boat setting race marks as he was in (and under) his Model T Ford and was a founding member of Skip Duggan Antique Car Club. He was a US Army vet and active in the PIB American Legion Post. John's many interests meant he touched many lives and he will be sorely missed.

## Leamington & Pelee Island Cruise-out

### August 19-20-21, 2011

Our Leamington, Canada cruise-out this year will be over the weekend of August 20th. As we did two year ago, for those who can get away a day early, we will have a Thursday evening Aug. 19th stop-over at Pelee Island. We have dock reservations at Scudder's Marina. While there, you can tour the island and then meet at the Pelee Island Winery for a wine and cheese rest stop. Following that, we will again enjoy a fabulous seafood and beef dinner at the Anchor and Wheel Inn.

Friday we will proceed to The Leamington Marina, where they have assured us that we will have our normal close-in moorings on their new E & F docks, which replaced the ones destroyed by a tornado last year. One advantage of the Pelee Island stop is that if the weather should turn bad, you are already over halfway to Leamington. If the weather is bad on Thursday, we'll just skip going to Pelee and leave for Leamington on Friday.

Friday evening we have reserved the marina's pavilion and grill. 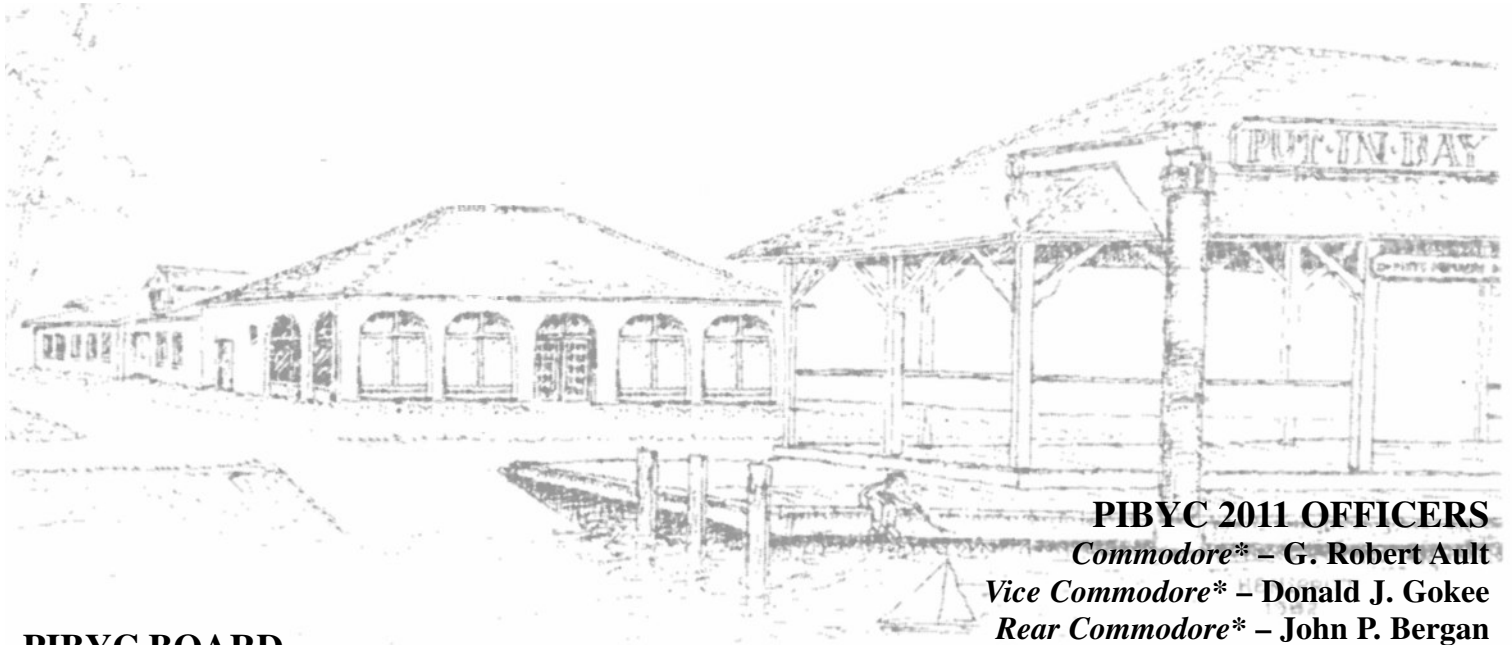
