### EVENT SCHEDULE

Vermilion Yacht Club, June 18, 2004. Arrive by 1800 hours for Friday night dinner at Red Clay on the river. In the morning, rolls and coffee available in clubhouse for nominal charge. Cookout will be at noon at the yacht club. Brats and hamburgers will be provided by PIBYC. Each person is asked to bring a covered dish to share. No beer or liquor on yacht club grounds. Saturday night will be at the Old Prague for "fine European dining". The cost for docking is \$1.65/ft. This is a "pay-as-you-go" event. Water taxis are available for tours or a trip to downtown, great shopping and the Inland Seas Maritime Museum. The sign-up sheet will be posted on May 22, 2004 at the clubhouse. This Vermilion event sign-up deadline is June 12, 2004.

Our next Cruise-Out is at Nor'easter Club, Catawba Island on Sunday, June 27, 2004. This is a dinner cookout at 1700 hours. Some people might want to drive to this event before departing for home. The cost of the event is \$18.00 per person. Please sign-up and pay for the event by the June 19, 2004 deadline.
