DOCK RESERVATIONS

We have dock space available for many weekdays and some weekends. Our docks began to fill at the Winter Party which was the first opportunity to make dock reservations for the coming summer. Please call Club Manager Noreen Roth at 419-285-4505 to make reservations. We basically have three dock spaces available ranging from 35-40 feet and will accept boats up to 45 feet. The water depth ranges from 3 to 5 feet. The cost is \$1.00/ft. for PIBYC members, \$1.25/ft for I-LYA members and \$1.50/ft. for non-members. Dockage includes electricity, 30 amp, 120V, water and restroom privileges.

Please notice our new 50-foot launching dock next to our launching ramp. This dock is a huge improvement in safety regarding launching of boats especially important for our young sailors. Credit for this improvement is given to our Past Commodore Bob Bahney Jr.. Bob, Past Commodore Steve Cooks and Past Commodore Clark Davies put the finishing touches to the dock in early May. We offer a big thank you.
